

Quarry Days Committee Meeting
August 1, 2022

Present: Kathy George, Ken & Ardie Johnson, Candi Nelson, Kristi & Tyler Zemke

Highlights of the discussion included the following:

- Touch base with Jodi regarding button sales and prizes
- Dimensions of the bounce house and obstacle course, as well as the National Guard events would be helpful in determining the layout at Train Park
- Weeds from the True Value property need to be cleared – the sawdust pile will be using that space
- Bingo discussion included the suggestion of getting carpenter aprons for the workers and what the payout will be
- Candi would like the lightbulbs at the bandshell changed to white bulbs
- T-shirts will be sold for \$20/Adults and \$15/kids; they are currently for sale at Chris' Food Center, Cheri's Flower Basket, and Members Credit Union
- Kristi plans to sell t-shirts at National Night Out
- Cassie has groups lined up to cover the bounce house & obstacle course
- The City's portable sound system will work great for the Coronation, Bingo and Parade
- The banner for Grand Marshal has been received; the outgoing Royalty will carry the banner in the parade
- There will be 2 or 3 non-crowned Junior Miss candidates that will need a ride in the parade – any ideas?
- Sarah passed out posters around Sandstone and Askov; others were asked to take posters and put them up as well
- Cambridge Bar & Grill backed out as a food vendor; they apparently double booked
- A Mexican food truck will be asked if they are available/interested
- New sponsors include Northview Bank (\$600), Essentia Health (\$500) and Arlen Krantz Ford (\$150 for the Kiddie Costume Contest)
- New craft vendors include Cheryl Zaudtke, JaLynn Cavallin, and Sharla Bengtson
- New information booth is Sandstone Options for Women
- Fireworks insurance rider was \$225
- The bounce house and obstacle course have been secured, cost is \$500
- \$250 was spent on the Every Door Direct mailing (printing costs)
- An updated list of Kids activities was provided
- Tables are needed for the Kiddie Costume Contest, the bouncy house/obstacle course, and wacky hair (all Friday night) and for the bouncy house/obstacle course and facepainting on Saturday – Kathy will secure tables from the City
- QD funds will be used to purchase bubbles, a small kid pool, and noodles for the splash pad
- Cassie is working on: promoting the kids activities, updating organizations/participants, ordering hair supplies, organizing prizes, finding judges for the costume contest

- A master to-do list was provided and everyone was asked to provide updates/changes as appropriate
