

Quarry Days Committee Meeting  
May 10, 2022

Highlights of the discussion included the following:

- New sponsorships: Methven Funeral Home (\$500), Minnesota Power (\$500), Quarry Lions (\$100) and Sandstone Lions (\$150)
- It would be great if we could get a \$1,000 sponsor for the band/street dance
- New Food Vendors: Hog Wild BBQ, Ann River Winery, Jamie Walker & Kendra McLeod; Tyler will check on a Chinese vendor, Kathy will follow up with Shaved Ice and Tree House
- New Info Booths: North Pine Area Hospital District
- New Crafters: PHASE Industries, Jolene Palme, Jessica Bade
- Ben's Hot Country Karaoke has been booked for Friday night for \$475
- Kaptain Kirby Train Rides are booked:
  - \$40 for the parade – Quarry Kids Child Care Center will sponsor this
  - \$200 for mileage
  - \$405 for 3 hours of train rides in Train Park from 11:00-2:00 Saturday
- A family friendly professional wrestling show for \$2,000 was turned down
- The City now owns the True Value building; this will be looked at for hosting Legos and the Library Book Sale
- Anytime Fitness is looking for 5K route options through town; once the route is determined, the City will have the course certified
- T-shirt options were reviewed and decided; Kristi will coordinate with Jodi to use the T-shirt design on the buttons
- Parade info is still needed from Jodi
- Discussion on holding fundraisers throughout the year – nothing was decided
- Ardie is still pursuing bouncy house options through Harvest Christian School/camp
- The National Guard has been confirmed, but the features they will bring are not yet known
- Ardie will look into having a sawdust pile for the kids
- Ardie will check with the Sandstone Riders Club regarding pony rides
- History Center approved a \$100 sponsorship
- History Tours are planned for Saturday at 1:00, 2:00, and 3:00; people can sign up at the History Center
- Tyler is considering headbands and trophies for the Basketball Tournament
- The Chamber will not help with Purse Bingo; Sirena will check with someone in Hinckley who recently held a Purse Bingo event
